Failure to follow proposal guidelines may result in removal of submissions from consideration.

All Music Education SIG Annual Meeting participants must be members of AERA and the Music Education SIG. Memberships expire on December 31 of each year. Join early to obtain the maximum benefit of AERA membership.

Graduate students who have papers selected for presentation are eligible to apply for a small travel stipend.
